Kerchaert Triumph Aluminum



The Triumph is a drop forged aluminum shoe that has an optimum front shape.

These shoes are commonly used by the Western Pleasure market as well as the Hunter and Thoroughbred shoer. Well-placed nail holes allow for good nailing and choices when the wall is less than perfect. The sole relief is built in - saving you time. The material is a high grade aluminum that provides good wear and strength. Shoes are symmetrical.

Punched for 4-1/2 Regular, 5 Race or 5 Slim.

NC Round Horn 82 Anvil



The NC Round Horn Anvil is perfectly balanced with a thin heel design. The anvil features turning cams on the heel, as well as a pritchel hole in the heel. There is a 2-5/8" square clip horn and a 1-1/4" chamfered round turning hole and a 1" hardie hole, which uses a 7/8" hardier shank, in the heel.

The NC Round Horn Anvil is 82 lbs. and 8-3/4" tall. The face is 4" x 11-3/4", horn is 4" x 8" and base is 10" x 9".

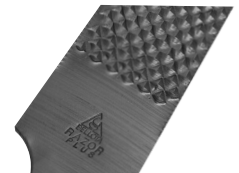
Kerchaert SX-8

The SX-8 is a 5/16" thick shoe with graduated widths. These shoes are used for trail, jumping, dressage and ranch work. Shoes are symmetrical. Sole relief on fronts. Punched for 5 City, 5 Slim or 5 Combo.



Bellota RAZOR Plus Rasp

Using a higher grade material for the Bellota RAZOR Plus rasp, it has proven in farrier testing to have a longer life. In addition, the tooth design is more aggressive and requires only a very light stroke in the early stages of using the rasp.
