In 2001, Jake earned his CJF from the American Farrier's Association and made the American Farriers Team in 2008, 2009 and again in 2014. At the Calgary Stampede in 2008 he earned Rookie of the Year and was a top ten finalist in 2008, 2009 and 2010.

In 2010 he won Reserve World Champion at the Calgary Stampede and in 2011 and 2014 he was overall high point at the American Farrier's Association Convention. Jake and his team Cat 6 have proudly won the World Horseshoeing Classic in both 2014 and 2015.

Currently Jake is participating in competitions in addition to judging and conducting clinics across the U.S. and internationally.

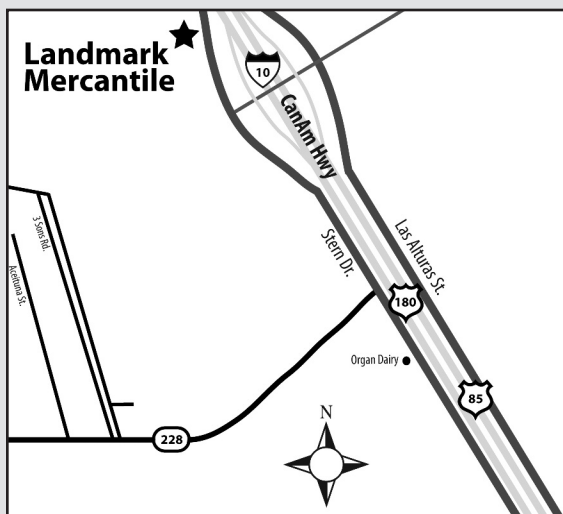

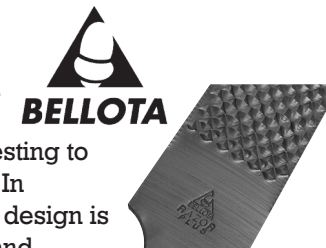
The Tradition series racing plates from Kerckhaert offer the North American market an option for shoeing styles and feet that require a narrower pattern than the Kings. The main design differences are the shape, a slight taper in the width from toe to heel, a nail pattern that is spread and punched slightly finer.

The Tradition clipped shoes are excellent in stall situations where concrete or cement block is the construction type. The clips of the Kerckhaert shoes are recognized for their strength and appropriate size.

The Tradition Quarter Horse Toe features a 8mm toe grab, used behind on some Thoroughbreds on dirt tracks and many racing Quarter Horses.

**Bellota Razor Plus Rasp**

Using a higher grade material for the Bellota RAZOR Plus rasp, it has proven in farrier testing to have a longer life. In addition, the tooth design is more aggressive and requires only a very light stroke in the early stages of using the rasp.
